## Federal Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Process

#### **DECISION TO PREPARE EIS**

#### **NOTICE OF INTENT**

The Notice of Intent is published in the Federal Register (complete).

#### **SCOPING PROCESS**

Purpose of scoping is to obtain information from interested parties, tribes, and the public in order to determine the range of actions, alternatives, and impacts to be considered in the EIS.

#### **DRAFT EIS**

The Draft EIS is prepared and published. The Draft EIS is expected to be available for public review and comment by January 2018.

## **PUBLIC REVIEW OF DRAFT EIS**

The Draft EIS is available for review for at least 45 days and the public is invited to comment on issues of concern. Additional public meetings may be held at this time.

### FINAL EIS

The Final EIS is prepared and published.

#### RECORD OF DECISION

The Record of Decision summarizes the lead Federal agency decision on the Proposed Action. A Record of Decision may not be signed until at least 30 days after publication of the Final EIS.
